

Aresti Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 'Cabina 56' (Curico, Chile) Ripe cassis and plum with a touch of coffee and sweet spice. This full bodied wine has a fine tannic structure and a long finish.	£33.00
Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Organic (Abruzzo, Italy) Ve Purple ruby red wine with an intense bouquet of red berry fruits and sour cherry. Full, harmonic and pleasantly tannic on the palate.	£33.00
