Overview

The FTSE Hong Kong Broad Bond Index (HKBBI) measures the performance of Hong Kong Dollar-denominated bonds. It includes fixed-rate securities issued in domestic and international markets that are accessible to institutional investors.

The HKBBI includes government, government-related and corporate bonds. The index covers a broad array of asset classes and sub-indices are available in any combination of asset class, maturity, and rating.

FTSE Russell offers a wide range of related indices, including the Hong Kong Broad Investment-Grade Bond Index. It tracks the universe of securities that meet the eligibility criteria for the flagship FTSE Hong Kong Board Bond Index with minimum credit quality either BBB- by S&P or Baa3 by Moody's.
